I am writing in hopes that you or your congregation will consider helping me and my wife Catharine return to full-time mission work. Bill McDonough has asked us to move to Siem Reap, Cambodia in October of 2014 to join him and his wife Marie-Claire and his mission work "*Partners in Progress*." Bill, who started serving as a missionary in 1965, is one of the brotherhood's longest-serving and most respected missionaries. *Partners in Progress* is the mission work that he cofounded in 1979. In order for this long-standing mission work to continue into the future, Bill will be training me to succeed him as its International Director.

I will be leaving my profession as a high school assistant principal, and Catharine will be leaving her profession as a registered nurse, therefore we need to raise support to cover our living expenses (\$XX,XXX per year or \$XXXX per month). Currently, we are almost half-way to this goal. The South Edmonton Church of Christ will oversee our support in Canada. Partners in Progress will oversee our support in the U.S.A. If thirty-three individuals and/or congregations each commit a minimum of \$XXX per month of on-going funding beginning in October 2014, we will be fully supported. However, we would be grateful to receive any amount that a person or congregation is able to give, whether as a one-time donation or as monthly, on-going support. We ask that no one takes away from the support they are giving to their local congregation or to other good works in order to assist us. All supporters will receive regular reports on our mission work, including a full financial accounting of all funds that we receive.
